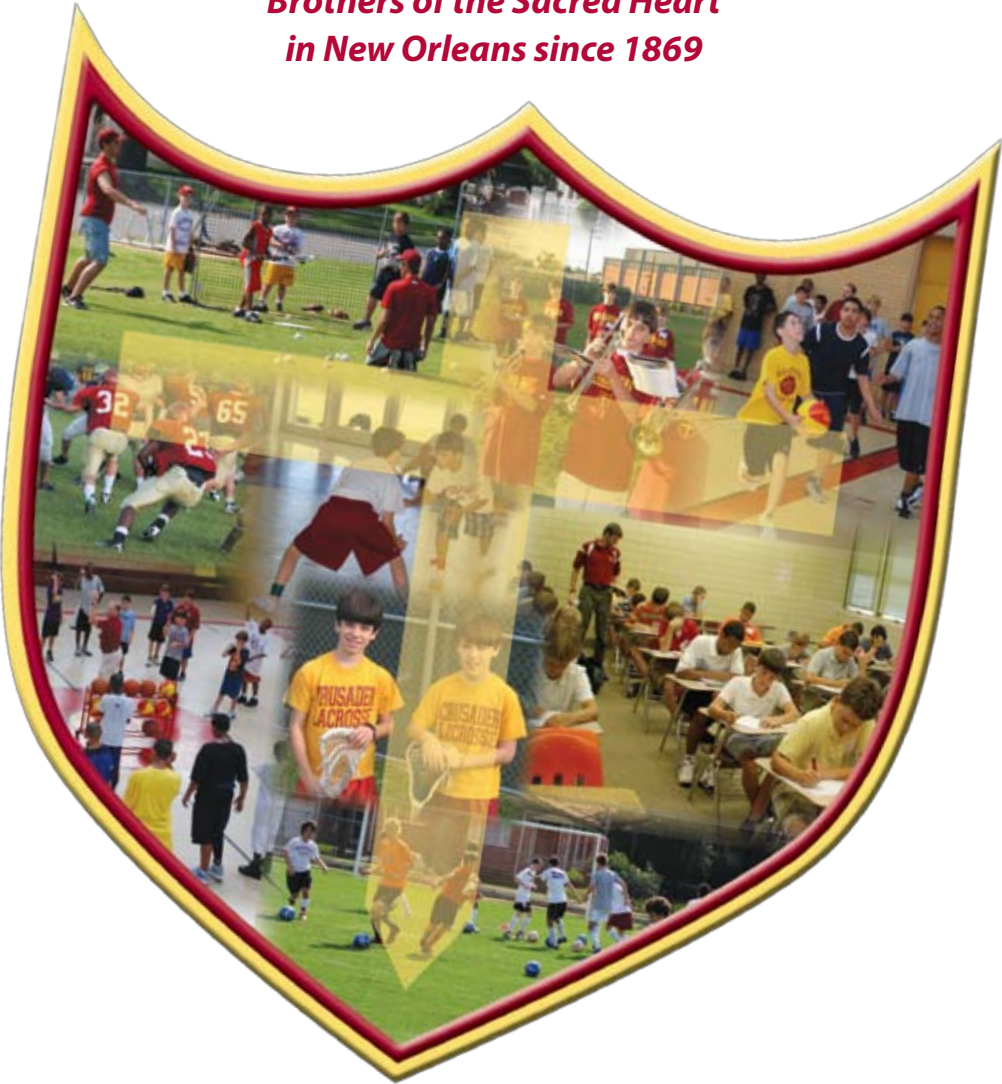

All students attending *athletic camps* may bring gear appropriate to the sports camp they are attending, with the exception of Lacrosse. Equipment for Lacrosse will be provided. Any other items needed for the athletic camp will be announced on the first day.

All students attending the *test preparation* course need to bring paper and pencil each day of class.

All students attending *band camp* need to bring their instrument each day of camp.

Proper Attire on the first day:

All students attending athletic camps may wear attire appropriate to the sport (t-shirts, shorts, tennis shoes, wrestling head gear, etc.). Art and academic program attendees should dress casually.

Registration Procedures:

Camps Fees must be paid in full upon registration.
